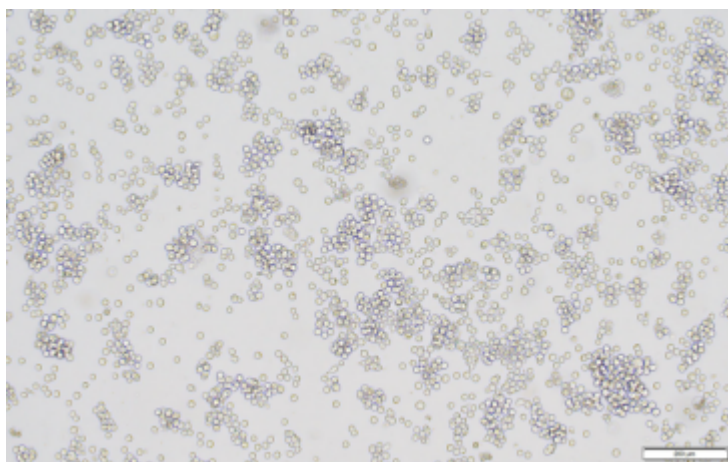


Fig1. Morphology of SNU-16 cell line.

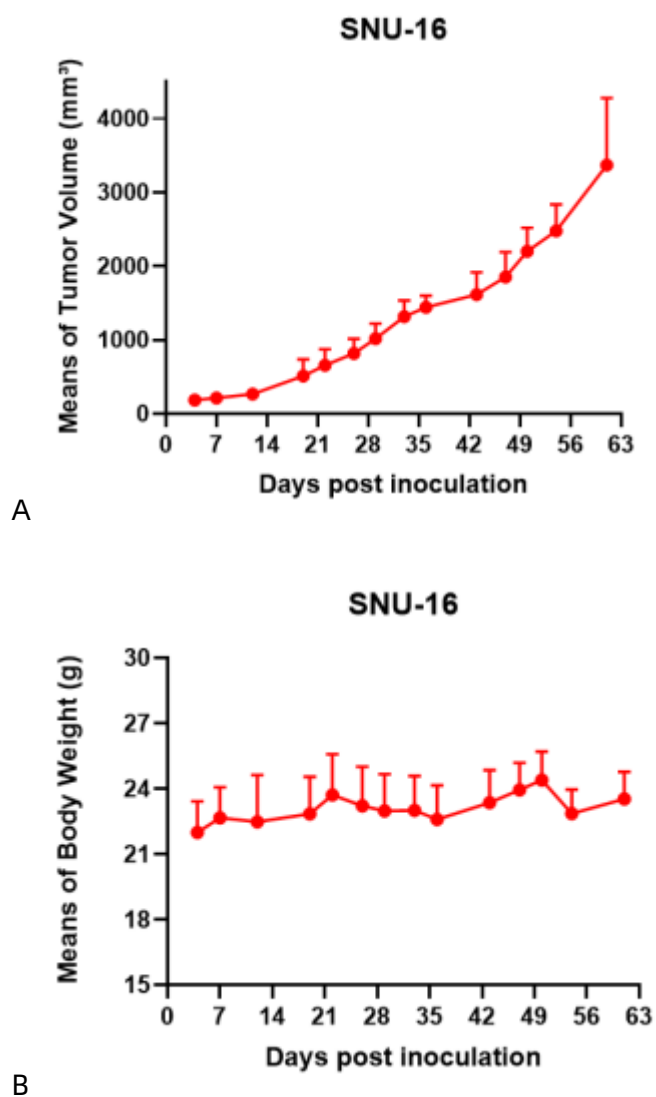
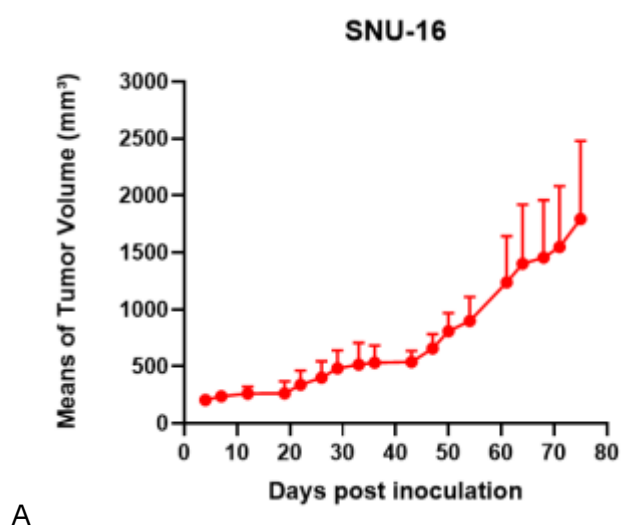
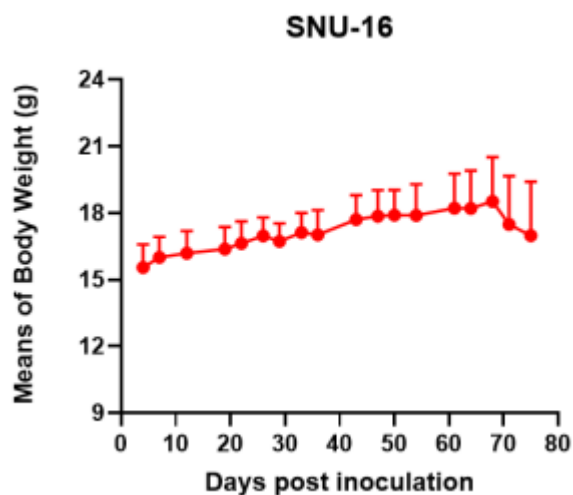


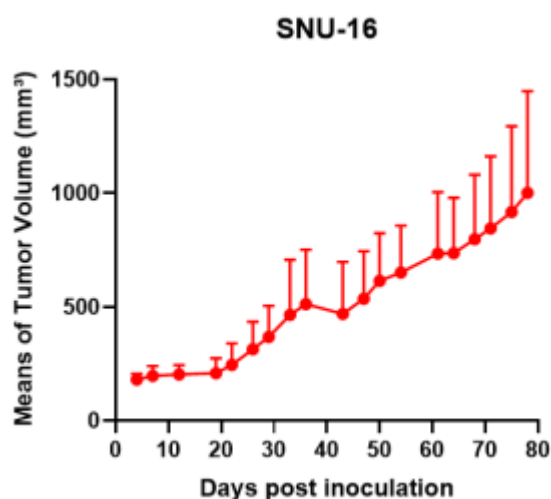
Fig2. Analysis of Tumorigenesis in M-NSG mice (n=6) . A Tumor volume was measured by time. B Body weight was simultaneously checked.



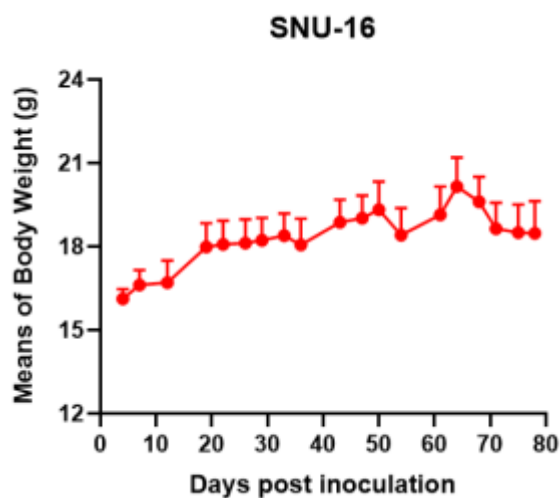
